The California State Grange does not address the central argument set forth in the motion to strike filed by the National Grange and Edward L. Luttrell. That is to say, regardless of the court's ruling on the demurrer to the Cross-Complaint, there is no conceivable basis for awarding punitive damages here. The California State Grange does not set forth authority, or otherwise distinguish, the cases cited by the National Grange establishing that as a matter of law punitive damages are not available under the related torts of intentional interference with contract or economic relations that are less formal than contracts. It does not even matter whether the National Grange is deemed a party to the supposed contract (through the bylaws). Nor does the California State Grange suggest that the facts alleged against the National Grange and Edward L. Luttrell regarding an internal disagreement within a private nonprofit organization rise to the level of outrageousness required for punitive damages under Civil Code section 3294. As such, the motion to strike punitive damages must be granted.
